NEW BUSINESS:

1. Director's Report

Mr. Gulledge will not give a formal "Director's Report" every month. Any questions by the board concerning his written report will be answered.

2. Tyler Peek, GDOT, District Engineer

Mr. Peek, District Engineer, oversees the GDOT's West District (District 3), which is headquartered in Upson County and oversees the transportation projects for Upson and 30 other counties in West Central Georgia. Mr. Peek attended the meeting with an update on GDOT projects. Recent projects in Upson County include the ongoing replacement of the Jeff Davis Road bridge over Ten Mile Creek, and a roundabout project on South Bethel Street. SR 36 (Woodland Road) bridge over Jerry Reeves Creek: This project will replace the existing culvert on SR 36 with a new bridge.

Mr. Fallin asked if a traffic study is necessary for future targets in Upson County.

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3. Jessica Hudson, Brightmark's Community Relations Representative

Ms. Hudson is serving as Brightmark's local representative; to support the company's mission and engage in the Thomaston-Upson community. Her report included Brightmark's resubmission of their air permit for the Circularity plant this month. A group of community leaders will be touring Brightmark's facility in Ashley, IN. on September 29th – 30th. Below is the list of attendees that will tour the plant in Ashley. 4. TUCIDA Implementation of the 2025 Strategic Plan

A **MOTION** was made by Mr. Rabalais, seconded by Ms. Rogers and approved to accept the 2025 Strategic Plan, with the understanding, this is a starting point for a living document, which will be changed and modified in future years.

5. Interfor Bond Inducement/ Resolution

A MOTION was made by Mr. Joyce, seconded by Mr. Brue and approved to move forward with the Interfor revenue bond in the amount up to 165 million dollars. Mr. Brooks updated the board on the company's refinancing the outstanding principal amount of the Series 2019 Bond, which will be refinanced, replace and cancelled. Investments in the Series 2019 Bond were not fully drawn and utilized to finance cost of the project. The bonds will mature in ten (10) installments paying in the years 2026-2035. The ordinary payment amount in any year shall not be less than \$234,481.48, and pilots will be adjusted to produce such result. The IDA 1/8 of 1% issuance fee in the amount of \$206,250.00 shall be paid on or before January 15, 2026. The county, school or IDA is not held responsible for this bond. Benjamin Brooks, Smith, Gambrell, and Russell will be drafting the final bond documents, with the expected closing date before December 31, 2025.
